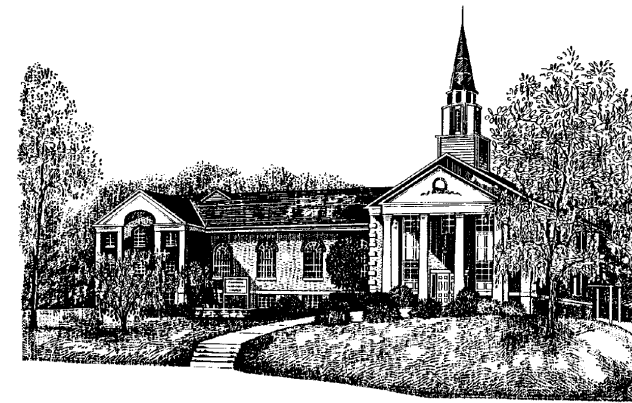

Missionaries

Angela Gianakos, our Missionary of the Month for February, serves with ReachGlobal in Greece. Angela, who is a member of Champion Pres, began her second year of service in Kypseli, a suburb of Athens, Greece, this past October. Last summer Angela helped lead "Operation Joshua" teams in July distributing Greek New Testaments throughout villages in northern Greece. In total, over 100,000 New Testaments were distributed in 865 villages by over 400 participants. Angela serves at a Community Center in Kypseli. Just this past December, they held a Christmas program for which twenty-eight neighborhood children showed up. They were treated to a puppet show, music, hot chocolate, popcorn, and much more. Each child received a "Christmas Bag", filled with toys, toiletries, and candy. During February they are launching a "New Kids Program" at the Community Center. Angela hopes to continue sharing Jesus' Love with both kids and adults in Kypseli through August if her support continues. So please lift up Angela with your prayers, and generously support her, that she may continue saying "Yes, to Jesus!" in Kypseli.

Emmanuel Lutheran Church's Mission, run by Lucille Bickel, is our local mission for February. The following are foods she really needs: spaghetti sauce; cereal, canned fruit, soup, and vegetables; pudding; jello; crackers; toilet tissue; paper towels; shampoo; deodorant; dish soap; and bar soap. Items may be dropped in the baskets in the Narthex near the Missions Map all this month.
