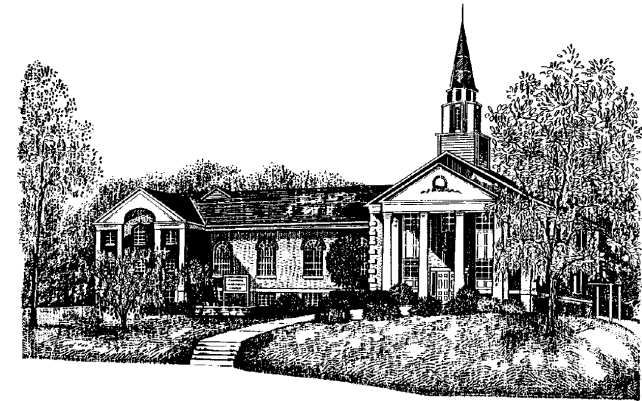
Fri-8 CHURCH OFFICE CLOSED

Lorien Knapp Sayayu experienced missions when she joined a team to Peru that Champion Pres was a part of.
